Comprehensive Examination Form

Students enrolled in the MS degree program must fulfill their degree requirement of completing a Comprehensive Examination. This form must be completed and submitted to the Administrative Office two (2) months prior to the scheduled date of the exam (see the semester course schedule for comp. exam date). If you fail to submit the completed application on time, you will have to wait until the next semester to take the exam. The comprehensive exam is held three (3) times a year: usually in April, July, and December.

The comprehensive exam consists of questions from six (6) core courses and one (1) elective course to be selected by the student when completing this form. The core course questions are standardized and computerized.
